

CDAC Workgroup Meeting

Campus Y

- Two equal classrooms; subdivided wall
- AV reserve will be provided: about 40,000 a class
- Projection screen on opposite sides of partition
- Einstein seating; do not know how many can fit
- Seminar/AV casework
- Each space is being done individually
- Is there a way to make a space that is usable as one classroom?
 - Two projection screens along window side
 - Campus Y probably did not want that
- If there was enough ceiling height, could do dual screen
- Have two projectors; one projecting a small image, other a large one
 - Could there be a switch that could be used instead of two projectors
 - Would have to buy two anyways, and a third for when it is open up
 - Three projectors total
- Ceiling height is 9 ft 10 in
- Is a total remodel job, so can raise the roof?
 - Maybe gain a foot
- Need to put speech reinforcement at the back of the room
- Partition going to stack on the surface of the wall
- What about turning it into a 25 person classroom with two screens?
 - Would not be able to sit people on the ends
- No blackboard/whiteboard in the room
- Will be minimally used
 - Probably not used on a day to day basis
 - Small seminars
- Would there be a benefit of taking these as ad-hoc classrooms?
 - Classroom hotline would then be scheduling 100% of the time
- Could move the screens in the corners, but blocks out seating capabilities
- Seating: 1 table per room; seats 15
- Option 1: In order to create one big room, put a screen (6 ½-7 feet) and space reinforcements
 - Without board space, will these classrooms be useful?
- Option 2: Moving to ad-hoc
 - Present to the whole committee, let Carol know
- Second option will be recommended to the committee
 - First option does work into that to make it a usable space
- Committee will reevaluate in a year
- Have two individual rooms that can be used as one large room
 - Then can have a wireless keyboard and mouse
 - Move podium

- For redesign, sticking with option number 2
- Still needs to go to whole committee
 - With table and chair layout
 - Suggest movable tables and chairs
- Jerry will send responses to workgroup
- Meet with Virginia to have a discussion about the room
- When discussed as an ad-hoc classroom, make sure it is stated as an **Ad-hoc General Purpose Classroom**
- If it is a 20-seat classroom, it can be schedule 80-90% of the time
 - Need the seating plan

Sciplex II Budget Meeting

- Two weeks ago
- Peter formally made a request to eliminate one more classroom from GP pool
 - Either a 30 or 40 seat room
- There are some budgetary problems
- First response, pull chemistry or computer classrooms to save money; not GP classroom
- On those ranges, cannot afford to take a hit
- Answer will be no, move on to other classes to cut money
