Transition:

- Keep workgroup going
- What is pending with Scott that needs to be passed forward?
- Sciplex II
  - Taking rooms away; has not been decided
  - Building is shrinking because increase of cost of materials
  - Cost of construction increased since three years ago
    - 20,000 sq. feet to 9,000 for library
  - Taken out underground tunnel
  - Next step to see what registrar's office is willing to give up
- Venable
  - Mostly chemistry, a few romance languages
  - Mostly Arts & Sciences
- Kenan money for Sciplex
  - Will have to put library in the building
  - Library not much bigger than a 30 seat classroom
- Would be willing to give up 1 or 2 30 seat classroom
  - Maybe give up 1 ½ of the 30 and add the other seats to another 30 to make a bigger room
    - After this comes online, will need larger sized classrooms
  - Contingent on the library
- Transition already occurred; Carol going to registrar

- Has Jeremiah received any money from Provost's office

- Has not received any money this year
- Scott reinitiated with Carol to see what happened and what will happen
  - Will check with Elmira
- Plan was to update the Gardner rooms, Dye rooms
  - Do not know if it is possible to do too much this summer even with the money
  - Do not know if it is possible to take rooms offline and move them someplace else for summer school

#### Future

- No information

- Will have to wait and here from the legislature
- The provost will not specifically assign to each area
  - Jerry will decide where to spend the money

#### Wireless request from the Law School

- If we can do all the other requests and the law school, yes
  - Otherwise, keep the money in GP classroom fund
